1. All entries should have name of variety on entry form.
2. Keep stems on entries, may be stored in plastic bags.
3. All fruit exhibits to be judged on the basis of soundness, maturity, color and trueness of type.
4. Agricultural exhibits must be products of 2023.
5. Do not polish fruit and leave stems on fruit.

Divisions 500–501

Judges Criteria: The following points shall be considered:
Shape, Color, Size, Uniformity, & Condition

DIVISION 501 - Youth

CLASS

- 1 Apples, any variety, four (4) apples
- 2 Beets, 4 medium-sized roots w/ 1" to 2" stems w/roots
- 3 Beans, Green or Purple, bush variety, four (4) pods
- 4 Beans, Wax, four (4) pods
- 5 Berry, any other type not listed, ten (10) berries or one cluster, any variety
- 6 Broccoli, one (1) head
- 7 Cabbage or Oriental varieties, one (1) head
- 8 Carrots, four (4) medium-sized roots 1" to 2" stems
- 9 Cauliflower, one (1) head
- 10 Corn, sweet, two (2) ears with husk & silks trimmed 1" back from tip to expose kernels.
- 11 Cucumber, pickling four (4) 1½" to 4" long
- 12 Cucumber, sliced, four (4) cucumbers, 5" to 8" long
- 13 Dill, one (1) stem w/all heads, must show seeds
- 14 Eggplant, one (1)
- 15 Garlic, two (2) bulbs
- 16 Grapes, One (1) bunch
- 17 Kohlrabi, purple or green, four (4) medium size roots with 1" to 2" roots
- 18 Lettuce, one (1) head
- 19 Melon, any variety, one (1) melon
- 20 Melon, honeydew, any variety, one (1) melon
- 21 Onion, bunch of ten (10) plants or four (4) mature bulbs with top steam twisted 3" about bulb
- 22 Parsley, one (1) bunch ¾" minimum diameter, tied
- 23 Peas, snap or edible- pod type, 4 pods, list type
- 24 Peppers, sweet, four (4)
- 25 Peppers, hot, four (4)
- 26 Plums, six (6) on stems
- 27 Potatoes, four (4) any variety
- 28 Pumpkin, one (1) any size
- 29 Radishes, three (3)
- 30 Rhubarb, four (4) pulled stalks, leave 1" of leaf end
- 31 Spinach, six (6)
- 32 Squash, winter, Hubbard, one (1)
- 33 Squash, winter, any other than Hubbard, one (1)
- 34 Squash, summer, crookneck, two (2)
- 35 Squash, summer, variety other than crookneck, two (2)
- 36 Strawberry, ten (10) berries, any variety
- 37 Tomatoes, green, four (4)
- 38 Tomatoes, ripe, four (4)
- 39 Tomatoes, green or ripe, four (4), 1½" or less

Fruits & Vegetables (Cont'd)

Divisions 500–501

- 40 Turnips, table, four (4) medium-size roots with 1" to 2" stems
- 41 Watermelon, one (1) melon
- 42 Zucchini, two (2) any variety, 8-12"
- 43 Plate of vegetables and/or fruit, 5 different kinds
- 44 Any other fruit not listed
- 45 Any other vegetable not listed

Herbs

Divisions 502–503

Any herbs used for seasoning, cooking, or for food preparation. Not for medicinal use only. Small herbs are shown on the stock in a bunch ½ inch in diameter at the base. If over ½ inch diameter, exhibit three stems, tie ends of herbs.
