## Open Static Premium Payouts

Entry limits have been lifted.

Premiums will only be paid once per class per exhibitor. I.e. John Doe has two entries in Department 4 (Open Foods Preservation), Division 409 (Dried Foods), Class 1 (Apples), they will only get premiums for their highest placing. Not both.

## Carcass Contest

If the minimum of 5 head per species are not entered there will be no class for that species.
