### Open Cattle

#### General Rules:

1. \$10 Fee per animal/per class required to enter into open class contests.

2. Read all Rules & Regulations on livestock in the General Rules and Youth Show rules. If you have any questions please call the Superintendent.

3. All exhibitors must enter into **Department 19** to reserve a stall. Refer to page 10 rule #7 in the General Rules: Exhibits & Exhibitor.

4. No cow calf pairs in the Champion Drive.

5. With the consent of all current dairy exhibitors and superintendents any lactating production cow, under stress due to changes in food, water and/ or other conditions shall be released if the exhibitor so wishes, for the benefit of the animals health, at the close of the dairy show on Friday afternoon. (As long as she has been on exhibit from Wednesday through the day of the dairy show.) This applies to lactating production animals only, including any dairy animal freshening during the fair. All other exhibits must stay in place until Sunday morning.

##### CLASS

- 1 Junior Bull Calf, 3-6 months old
- 2 Senior Bull, Calf, 7-12 months old
- 3 Yearling Bull, 1 year or older (up to 2 years old)
- 4 Any Age - Breeder Bull
- 5 Junior Heifer Calf, 3-6 months old
- 6 Senior Heifer Calf, 7-12 months old
- 7 Junior Yearling Heifer, 13-18 months old
- 8 Senior Yearling Heifer, 19-24 months old but not yet fresh
- 9 Junior get-of-sire, group consists of four (4) animals under two (2) years old, none of which has freshened, either sex. The get of one sire; not more than two bulls. Sire must be names & each exhibitor is limited to one entry sired by the same bull. At least three (3) animals must be bred by exhibitor. Animals may be owned by one or more exhibitors.
- 10 Two year old cow, springing or milking 25-36 months old
- 11 Three year old cow, 37-48 months old
- 12 Four year old cow, 49-60 months old
- 13 Aged cow, 5 years and over, still in show condition
- 14 Best Three Females, any age, all bred & owned by exhibitor. Exhibitor limited to one group.
- 15 Breeder Get-of-sire, group consists of four (4) animals, either sex. Not more than two (2) bulls any age. At least three (3) animals must be bred by exhibitor. Sire to be named.
- 16 Produce of Dam, group to consist of two (2) animals, any age, either sex, the product of one (1) cow. The dam must be named. Each exhibitor is limited to one (1) group entry from the same dam. All animals owned by the exhibitor.
