General Rules:

1. Any article that has received an award in a previous Park County Fair is not eligible for entry.

2. Exhibits displaying a Business Name, Price tag or for sale sign will be removed from the competition.

3. Duplicate entries will not be allowed in different classes.

4. Entries must be solely completed by the person entering the project.

5. All Open Class YOUTH competitions are for exhibitors 18 years and under, ADULT competitions are for exhibitors 19 years or older. (Ages as of Jan. 1st of current year).

Age is required on the entry form or exhibit will be disqualified.

Senior, ages: 65 years and older

Adult, ages: 19 years or older

Youth, ages: 18 years old and younger

Child, ages: 6 years to 10 years old

Tot, ages: 1 year to 5 years old

6. Classification of work will be:

A. Professional: refers to those who derive significant income from art/ crafts and whose work is produced primarily for the purpose of selling; or who have a diploma, certificate, degree or three or more years of school training; or teach in their visual arts media.

B. Advanced Amateur: refers to those who have exhibited and won first prize in accredited or recognized shows; or who have had professional schooling but have not completed more than three years.

C. Amateur: refers to those who have not won first prizes in accredited or recognized shows; or who had had little or no schooling.

D. Youth: refers to those who have not reached their 19th birthday before January 1 of the current year.
