### General Rules:

1. All entries should have name of variety on entry form.
2. Keep stems on entries, may be stored in plastic bags.
3. All fruit exhibits to be judged on the basis of soundness, maturity, color and trueness of type.
4. Agricultural exhibits must be products of 2026.
5. Do not polish fruit and leave stems on fruit.

## Fruits & Vegetables

Divisions 501– 502

**Judges Criteria:** The following points shall be considered:  
Shape, Color, Size, Uniformity, & Condition

### CLASS

- 1 Apples, any variety, four (4) apples
- 2 Beets, 4 medium-sized roots w/ 1" to 2" stems w/roots
- 3 Beans, Green or Purple, bush variety, four (4) pods
- 4 Beans, Wax, four (4) pods
- 5 Berry, any other type not listed, ten (10) berries or one cluster, any variety
- 6 Broccoli, one (1) head
- 7 Carrots, four (4) medium-sized roots 1" to 2" stems
- 8 Cucumber, pickling four (4) 1½" to 4" long
- 9 Cucumber, sliced, four (4) cucumbers, 5" to 8" long
- 10 Dill, one (1) stem w/all heads, must show seeds
- 11 Eggplant, one (1)
- 12 Garlic, two (2) bulbs
- 13 Grapes, One (1) bunch
- 14 Kohlrabi, purple or green, four (4) medium size roots with 1" to 2" roots
- 15 Lettuce, one (1) head
- 16 Melon, any variety, one (1) melon
- 17 Onion, bunch of ten (10) plants or four (4) mature bulbs with top stem twisted 3" about bulb
- 18 Parsley, one (1) bunch ¾" minimum diameter, tied
- 19 Peas, snap or edible- pod type, 4 pods, list type
- 20 Peppers, sweet, four (4)
- 21 Peppers, hot, four (4)
- 22 Plums, six (6) on stems
- 23 Potatoes, four (4) any variety
- 24 Pumpkin, one (1) any size
- 25 Radishes, three (3)
- 26 Rhubarb, four (4) pulled stalks, leave 1" of leaf end
- 27 Spinach, six (6)
- 28 Squash, winter, Hubbard, one (1)
- 29 Squash, winter, any other than Hubbard, one (1)
- 30 Squash, summer, crookneck, two (2)
- 31 Squash, summer, variety other than crookneck, two (2)
- 32 Strawberry, ten (10) berries, any variety
- 33 Tomatoes, green, four (4)
- 34 Tomatoes, ripe, four (4)
- 35 Tomatoes, green or ripe, four (4), 1½" or less
- 36 Zucchini, two (2) any variety, 8-12"
- 37 Plate of vegetables and/or fruit, 5 different kinds

- 38 Any other fruit not listed  
39 Any other vegetable not listed

## Herbs

Divisions 503– 504

Any herbs used for seasoning, cooking, or for food preparation. Not for medicinal use only. Small herbs are shown on the stock in a bunch ½ inch in diameter at the base. If over ½ inch diameter, exhibit three stems, tie ends of herbs.
